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1.0 Introduction

This document describes the internal configuration settings for the different applications of the PAC24 Audio Control Panel. Switch settings are described in several different ways, text, table and graphically. So if it seems redundant or complicated, don't worry. Just pick the representation that works best for you.

In pictures where the switches are grayed out, these switch settings are not relevant to the settings being described, but will be detailed in a different location.

To further help avoid confusion, the specific audio panel settings for the second audio panel in dual systems are color coded, **Copilot** audio panel and **Observer's** audio panel.

1.1 Applicability

1.2 Detail unit description

PAC24 Standard (050-240-0100) is applicable to single or dual installations. It will directly replace a King KMA24H -71.

Note: Some installations may have a privacy/isolate switch or switches installed. These may have to be removed and/or bypassed. See complete installation manual for details.

The PAC24 Observer version (050-240-0400) is a special model that will accommodate three crew members transmitting, using two audio panels. One audio panel is for the crew (pilot and copilot) and the Observer's audio panel services that position, and dedicated communications radios. This version is ALWAYS installed as a dual system, and the two units *always* have identical part numbers.

The PAC24 is available in Vertical Orientation (050-240-0500). These units are configured in the same manner as the -0100 units.


The PAC24 (050-240-0503) was also sold into special mission versions, which are beyond the scope of this document. Contact the factory if details are needed.

2.0 PAC24 Standard (050-240-0100) DIP switch Configurations

To change the DIP (Dual Inline Package) switch, remove the TOP cover of the PAC24 by removing the two screws at the sides. The switches will be visible at the rear of the unit. Use a small screwdriver or pencil to slide the switch "On" or "Off." Be careful not to break the switch.

2.1 Single PAC24

As originally shipped from PS Engineering, the units are configured as Single Panel installation, 28-volt aircraft, without expansion. This is suitable for a single panel, pilot and copilot operation, with up to three passengers. The passenger headphone audio is paralleled with the copilot, so a true "crew" mode is not possible.





Figure 2 Switch Positions, PAC24 Single Unit Standard

2.2 Single PAC24 with Expansion

The PAC24 (-0100) can be expanded. This will add up to 6 places for passenger intercom, and a stereo music input for them. It will also give the system a true "crew" mode, where the pilot and copilot positions will not hear the passengers, the passengers will not hear the crew, or the aircraft radios in the CREW mode.

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This configuration requires that S2, S3 and S5 to be changed.




Figure 3 Switch Positions, PAC24 Single Panel with expansion



2.3 Dual PAC24

Two PAC24s can be combined to give full audio control to both pilot and copilot positions. Function logic is shared between units to prevent any unusable states from occurring, such as two pilots transmitting on the same radio. The audio panel that is designated as Pilot's will have priority in transmitting, and that audio panel intercom mode selector (ISO/ALL/Crew) will be functional.

Up to three passengers can be connected to each audio panel, and these positions will hear the other panel's passengers. Note: Passengers headphones are shared with the copilots so CREW function will not work unless expansion 11606 is installed.






Figure 5 Switch positions, Dual PAC24 Copilot's audio panel

2.4 Dual PAC24 Installation, with Expansion

Two PAC24s can be combined with IntelliVoxTM expansion units. This provides up to 12 passengers and 2 crew positions. This configuration provides a true "crew" mode, where the passengers can be isolated from the crew and will not hear aircraft radios.

This configuration requires that S2, S3 and S5 be changed.

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


Figure 6 Diagram of Dual PAC24 with expansion

3.0 Circuit jumper positions

Two circuit jumpers are used to control the microphone audio and radio P-T-T path for fail safe configuration. These jumpers are located at the rear corner of the PAC24. Remove the top cover as described in $\S 2.0$.




Figure 9 Jumpers J4 and J5 positions

4.0 Other Switch settings

4.1 Switch 4


The PAC24 has PS Engineering's patented "swap" mode that allows the pilot to switch the com radio selected for transmit by pushing an optional momentary switch located on the yoke, panel or cyclic as convenient. This allows changing the radio without having to let go of the controls and reach the audio panel.


This "swap input is shared with the lighting bus, such that in a 28-volt aircraft, the lighting bus is input on pin U, and swap is implemented by grounding pin 18. In a 14-volt

aircraft, the pin assignments are reversed, and S4 is changed to accommodate this configuration.


Figure 11 S4 Switch positions 14-Volt 28-volt

4.2 S5 Position 4, TEL


The PAC24 can be used to interface a cellular or satellite telephone into the aircraft audio system, as COM 5. In this case, S5, position 4 must be in the "ON" position to allow a full duplex operation on COM 5.

5.0 PAC24 Observer versions (050-240-0400)

This configuration allows three transmit positions, with the observer access to the communications transceivers connected to the audio panel designated as observer. These can be, but are not necessarily the ones used by the crew, or a combination thereof. The Observer version is a **special part number** of the PAC24 (-0400).

This is *always* a dual installation, and both part numbers *must* be the same (-0400).

The DIP switches are set at the factory, and the audio panels are individually labeled "**Crew**" and "**Observer**." The settings are provided here for reference.

5.1 Dual PAC24 Observer, with 1 passenger (no expansion).

In this configuration, the observer unit can support one additional passenger on the intercom, for a total of four persons on the aircraft audio system. This configuration can only support one passenger besides the crew and observer because the microphone inputs are used for the observer panel interface.





Figure 13 System diagram Dual PAC24 Observer without expansion.


Figure 14 Switch positions, Dual PAC24 Observer, <u>Crew's</u> panel


Figure 15 Switch positions, Dual PAC24 Observer, Observer's panel



5.2 PAC24 Observer Installation with Expansion

If up to six additional intercom positions are desired, an IntelliPax expansion unit, P/N 11606, can be interfaced with the Observer's audio panel. These intercom positions will be heard in both crew and observer panels, unless the intercom is in "Crew" mode.




Figure 17 Switch positions, Dual PAC24 Observer with expansion, Crew's panel Refer to Section <u>4.0</u> for settings of S4 and S5, Switch 4.




Figure 19 DIP Switch Schematic representation
